

Let's rock the end of the season in Germany's 1st Obstacle Kite Park from September 28th – 30th!

General information

We would like to invite you to our new obstacle park for kiteboarding in Saal, Germany. Between the 28th and 30th of September we will have a season ending event at our surf station. During this event we want to open the obstacle park. There will be some jam sessions & parties and an open contest were we play K.I.T.E. over the obstacles (rules you find below).

The park consist of a floating kicker (I = 3.5m, w = 2m, h = 1m), a floating slider (straight box 9m length, 0.7m height) and the slider you see in the pic in top of the sheet (including a straight extension). Hopefully we will have time to add some funny extras to the park. Feel free to share your idea's with us.

How to register for the event...?

- for registrations please contact Claas (see contact info above)
- registration in advance is also possible on-site, we would be happy to receive your registration in advance so your participation can be guaranteed!

Play K.I.T.E. with us...?

- First, decision on order of turns will be made by Ro! Sham! Bo!
- The first rider then chooses an obstacle and makes any kind of trick over it.
- If Rider 1 makes the trick, Rider 2 has to try to make the same trick over the same obstacle or a progression from this trick.
- If Rider 2 makes the trick then Rider 3 (or Rider 1 depending on how many players you have) attempts the same trick...so on and so forth.
- But if Rider 1 misses that first trick, the second Rider becomes the "leader." If Rider 2 makes the trick, the other Riders must make the same trick or progression...so on and so forth.
- If any Rider beside Rider 1 make a progression on the trick every Rider in the heat has to show that he can make also the progression or a even more advanced progression.
- Each time a Rider misses a trick, another letter is added to their score, beginning with *K*, then *I*, *T*, and finally, *E*. When a Rider spells *KITE*, he is out of the game.
- The last person standing wins.
- Maximum number of Riders per heat is 4.
- SAFETY: All Riders must wear helmets and impact vests not only during the contest also during the jam sessions! Please ride finless or make sure your fins can't damage the obstacles or lock yourself on the same...

Where to park and sleep...?

Option 1:

- you can put up a tent/ park your car directly at the Surfbus area on the lawn for 6€/ night
- no shower but you are sleeping on the waterfront, facilities are provided

Option 2:

- the hostel close by (a nice manor house, distance approx. 10-15min by car) for 15€/night per person, including breakfast
